
## DOWNTOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT



<u>HISTORIC DESIGN REVIEW REQUIRED</u> prior to any exterior modifications of structures within the area above. Exterior modifications include anything that changes the appearance of the structure, including, but not limited to: building modifications, façade changes, and painting of the structure. Additionally, all new and modified signage and window signage requires historic design review.

All applications must be submitted to the Building and Planning Department, final decisions on all applications are made by the City Historic Preservation Commission (HPC). The HPC meets each 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month at 3:30 pm. Applications must be received a minimum of 10 days prior to the HPC meeting they are to be heard at. HPC meetings are noticed and open to the public.
